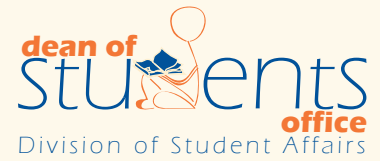


DEAN OF STUDENTS OFFICE

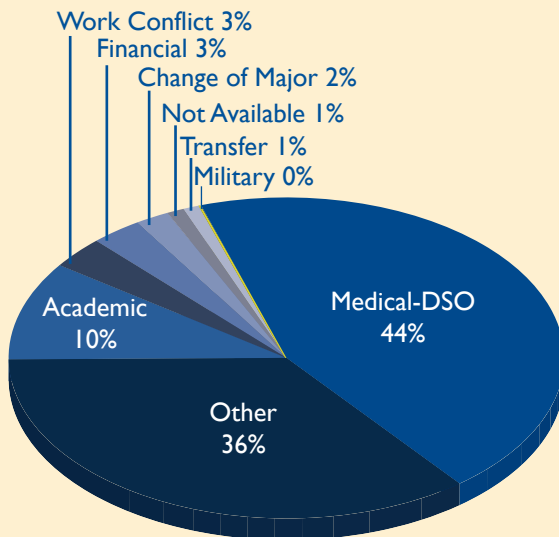

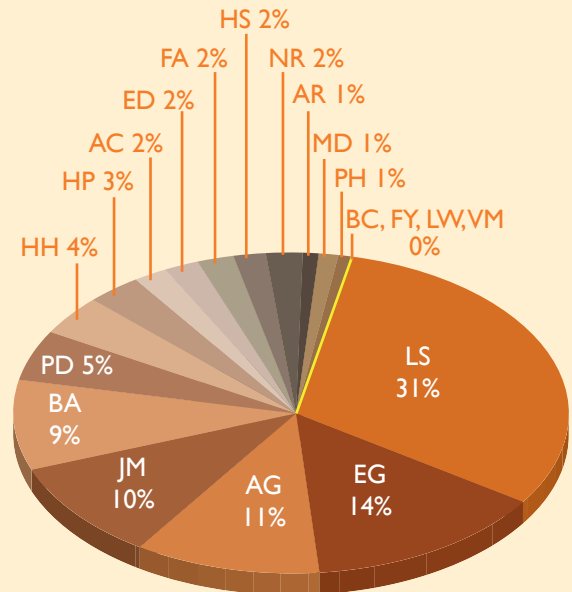

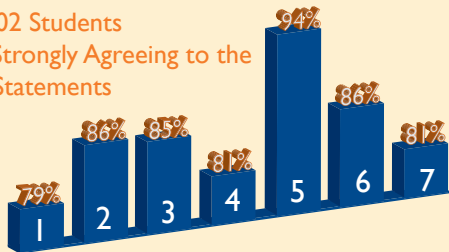
